Ideas for use: 1) Cut out around each section and glue onto colorful construction paper pages, or print pages back-to-back and fold over one side to make a four-part page that can be hole-punched and fit into an 8½ x 5½ binder. If doing the latter, trim off the outside edge so it doesn't overlap the holes. 2) Give each child their own word library for personal use, or make one or more copies for everyone to share. 3) Before writing assignments, allow children to thumb through the word library for inspiration or to help fill out brainstorming/pre-writing charts. 4) During writing and revising, allow children to use the word library to find the spelling of a particular word, and/or for help thinking of words. 5) Individual pages can also be used in bulletin board displays, or as mini "word walls" where children can browse many pages at once. **NOTE:** This section and the title at the top do NOT appear on actual Word Library pages. This information instead is found on an introductory page in a larger font.
